Full-stack web developer with a long background in digital product design and front-end implementation, now focused on Craft CMS and modern frontend tooling. I build accessible, performance-minded sites with clean content models and maintainable Twig templates (Craft CMS 5, Tailwind, Vite). I'm early in Craft CMS specifically, but I bring years of CMS-driven delivery from WordPress, so the learning curve is mostly Craft-specific patterns and conventions rather than fundamentals. Used to remote-first, mostly async collaboration and full ownership from 15 years of freelancing. Looking for a junior-mid role in Berlin where I can contribute immediately on Craft/front-end work and keep growing backend depth.
